Toolbox Talks is a three year project that will deliver training to employees in the male dominated mining and construction industries.

Commencing in October 2017, *Toolbox Talks* will be delivered weekly to employees at mining and construction companies in the greater Sydney and Hunter Valley regions.

The Toolbox Talks training will provide information on domestic and family violence and outline alternative options and conversations that men can have with their peers around violence. Referrals to support services will also be made where appropriate.

The project aims to improve understanding of the dynamics, impacts and complexities of domestic and family violence.
